

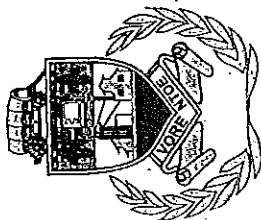

GOVERNING BODY ELECTION:

You are hereby reminded of the Governing Body election on Thursday, 8 April 2021 at 18:00 in the school hall. We would like to remind you to bring along your South African identity document, without it you cannot vote. Nomination forms for parents are available in the office from Wednesday, 31 March 2021.

ROAD SAFETY

We urge parents to talk to your children regarding road safety. Learners need to use the demarcated crossings in front of the school. No learners may walk between the busses or in the road.

TEST CYCLE:

The official test cycle will continue next week. The test session only makes up a third of the school day. The rest of the day is normal academic time. NO learner will be given permission to write the test at any other time! We find it strange that parents do not comprehend the seriousness of the situation. Ensure that your child studies diligently every day. Limit cell phone usage and access to the television. The workload is relatively light so there is opportunity to achieve good marks.

ABSENTEEISM DURING THE TEST SERIES:

In the event of a learner missing a test, a medical certificate must be handed in otherwise the learner will be awarded a ZERO!

CHECKLIST FORM:

Parents that applied for subsidy received a checklist form. Please complete the checklist form and give it to your child to hand in to the homeroom teacher. There are also Health forms and Code of Conduct slips outstanding. Gr 8 parents are reminded to hand in the 2020 Gr 7 report cards and transfer cards to the homeroom teachers. This is just a checklist. The application forms for subsidy were collected at the school's office and be returned before the closing date of 15 March 2021.

BEHAVIOUR AND FIGHTING:

No bullying or fighting will be accepted on the school premises. Learners not adhering to this will be suspended as it is a direct infringement of the school's Code of Conduct. Parents, we implore you to teach your children not to become involved in behaviour that could bring the school into disrepute.

SELLING ON SCHOOL PREMISES:

No selling of any goods are allowed on the school premises. Goods will be confiscated and not returned. As a school we have to protect other learners. Please work with us in this regard. Learners that do not listen, will be suspended.

CLEANING BOKSBURG LAKE:

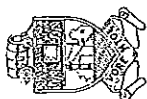

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NOTICE OF NOMINATION MEETING FOR PARENTS

NAME OF SCHOOL: Hoërskool Voortrekker DISTRICT : Ekurhuleni South

Notice is hereby given that a meeting for the nomination of candidates for the election of nine (9) members of the governing body of the above-mentioned school, will be held on 8 April 2021 at 18:00 at Hoërskool Voortrekker.

Candidates (who must be parents / guardians of learners at the school and who are not employed at the school) may be nominated by submitting to the Electoral Officer a nomination form, duly completed by the candidate and his/her proposer and secondor. Both the proposer and secondor must be parents / guardians of learners at the school. The nomination form must be returned to the school at least one day before the elections are concluded.

If a quorum of parents is not present, notice is given that a second meeting for the nomination and election of nine (9) members of the School Governing Body for the above mentioned school will be held in the school's hall on 22 April 2021 at 18:00. A quorum is not required for this meeting to proceed. Nominations will be accepted at the school from 8:00 on 1 April 2021, until 7 April 2021.

NB: It is the responsibility of parents/guardians to ensure that their names are on the school's admissions register, which can be viewed at the school. Only parents whose names are on the school's admissions register/voter's roll will be entitled to participate in the school's governing body election.
