

Hoërskool Voortrekker

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At the School Governing Body Meeting held on 24 November 2022, the SGB members accepted the unanimous vote of the parents in favour of all resolutions as set out in the Agenda of the Annual Budget Meeting on 24 November 2022.

Resolutions 1 to 10 were presented to the parents at the Annual Budget Meeting and all 10 resolutions were approved with a unanimous vote.

Hoërskool Voortrekker remains a fee-paying school for the year 2023.

Hoërskool Voortrekker will re-appoint Marais and Alcock incorporated Chartered Accountants as Auditors for 2023.

The governing body is authorized to supplement any deficits that may arise on budgeted amounts for particular budget items or change line items, from surpluses that may arise on other items, provided that the total budget shall not be exceeded without obtaining the approval of a parent meeting.

The following academic and extra mural programme was adopted. (see page 2)

The following activities are excluded from the school programme. (see page 2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 38 and 39 (1) of the South African Schools Act (SASA), school fees be determined and shall be payable at this school in accordance with the approved budget by the SGB. In light of the above the school fees for next year are confirmed as the following:

School fees (Gr 8-12)

Total Annual Fee for 2023: R14 795.00

Discounted payment: R14055.25 (paid before 1 February 2023. Only if total fees/account are up to date)
Fees are due and payable in advance and are due and payable on the 1st January 2023. If parents are unable to pay the fees upfront, they may be paid in 11 equal instalments of R 1345.00 commencing on the 1st January and ending the 1st November 2023.

The full year's outstanding school fee shall immediately become due and payable if any installment is not paid on specified due date. All parents agreed that Section 41 of Act 84 regarding the enforcement of School Fee payment should be strictly adhered to. The school has the right to trace parents for information as well as blacklist parents for nonpayment of school fees.

The School has the right to allocate all money received from parents first to school fees. In accordance with Accounting principles, money received will be allocated to the oldest debt first.

School tours, outings and visits by performing groups and personal stationary are not compulsory for the school programmes and thus carry additional costs to parents. Funds for school tours will be raised by parents and children.

The criteria for the total, partial or conditional exemption of parents, who are unable to pay compulsory school fees, will be determined in accordance with the criteria set out in The Exemption of Parents from School Fees Regulations (as amended in Government Gazette 3392 of 17 November, 2006).

A parent who wishes to be exempted from the payment of school fees for a child at Hoërskool Voortrekker, shall apply annually in writing by completing the relevant forms collected from the Finance Office Secretaries and by submitting the forms along with any required documentation to the school within 7 working days of receiving the forms. The application will be considered by the SGB in light of the correctness and completeness of information submitted by every parent.

The parent shall attend an interview with the School Bursar or SGB Finance Committee.

The FINCOM will evaluate each application by applying the relevant legislation and regulations before granting or declining an application. Applicants will be informed, in writing, by the SGB of the outcome of the parent(s) lodging the application, provided that all relevant documentation was submitted with the application.


The budget for 2023, as table, which reflects the estimated cumulative effect of established trends of non-payment and of the total, partial or conditional exemption likely to be granted to parents in terms of the Regulations, is approved.

The SGB is authorized to make payments to state-employed and SGB-employed members of staff in terms of Section 38A payments as reflected in the budget as tabled, is approved.

The SGB reserves the right to maintain a database of debtor's information. The school may hold and process by computer or otherwise, any information obtained about parents as a result of their liability for payment of school fees. The SGB reserves the right to communicate, inter alia, via fax, D6 communicator, WhatsApp, website and e-mail.

Payments made into the account of Hoërskool Voortrekker by any parent who subsequently qualifies for an exemption, would be regarded as a voluntary school fee contribution and no such payment will be refunded.
