1. REPORTS:

Report cards for grade 8 – 12 learners can be collected from the respective homeroom teachers at the parents evening, 23 March 2023. Parents must sign the copy and take the original home for their perusal. Please take note of your child's academic achievements in each subject as well as the Code of Conduct for Term 1.

2. MONITORING AND ACCESS TO SCHOOL GROUNDS:

Please take note that the staff are only at school from 7:00, Monday to Friday. Learners who are dropped off earlier must always be vigilant. They must be weary of walking around in the streets, standing on sidewalks or playing in the streets. We cannot be held responsible for their safety if they do not adhere to the rules.

Staff are on grounds and gate duty from 7:15 to 14:15, Monday to Friday. Learners who wait for transport after school must wait inside the gate in the area in front of the netball courts. It is too dangerous for learners to wait outside. We implore all parents to speak to your children about their safety. It is unacceptable for learners to walk in the streets without any regard for traffic or playing soccer in the street while waiting for transport to arrive. Learners must also take note of any demarcated areas inside the school grounds that have been cordoned off due to construction of buildings or any other area where repairs may be conducted. Learners must refrain from the workshop area where ground staff conduct repairs.

3. GRADE 12 HOLIDAY CLASSES:

It is compulsory for ALL grade 12 learners to attend the holiday classes scheduled from Friday 24 March until THURSDAY 30 March 2023. If learners want success they need to work towards attaining that goal through attending the classes. The grade 12 staff are dedicated and offer these additional classes for free.
